

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NEWMARKET

BY-LAW NUMBER 2001- 100

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 1996-38 BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE REMOVAL OF SNOW AND ICE FROM SIDEWALKS IN THE TOWN OF NEWMARKET

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend By-law 1996-38, being a by-law to provide for the removal of snow and ice from sidewalks in the Town of Newmarket;

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Newmarket as follows:

1. THAT By-law 1996-38 Section 3, be amended by:


deleting the following:

"The occupant of every parcel of land or premises which fronts or abuts any highway upon which there is a sidewalk, or in case there is no occupant, the owner or person or persons having control of such land or premises shall, within twenty four hours after any fall of snow, rain or hail shall have ceased, remove or cause to be removed "entirely" from the portion of the sidewalk opposite such land or premises snow and ice resulting from such fall of snow, rain or hail."


and replacing it with the following:

"The occupant of every parcel of land or premises which fronts or abuts any highway upon which there is a sidewalk, or in case there is no occupant, the owner or person or persons having control of such land or premises shall, within twenty four hours after any fall of snow, rain or hail shall have ceased, remove or cause to be removed from the portion of the sidewalk opposite such land or premises snow and ice resulting from such fall of snow, rain or hail "such that such sidewalk is in a safe, passable condition."
