The purpose of this information report is to advise Members of Council of a request for an exemption from the Noise By-law (By-law 2004-94) to allow for the required replacement of rail track and related road repairs on Water Street and Timothy Street in Newmarket. The work is being undertaken jointly by the Town and Metrolinks between Friday April 15, 2016 and Sunday April 17, 2016 including overnight between 8:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m. when construction noise is prohibited.


Noise exemptions are normally granted by Council; however, due to the time sensitivity and in the absence of a scheduled Council meeting, staff will be approving the request in accordance with past practice.

In accordance with the Procedure By-law, any Members of Council may request an Information Report to be placed on an upcoming Committee of the Whole agenda for discussion.

To advise the local community of the works, the Town has placed electronic message board in the area, in addition to an advertisement in the local paper.
