CANADA DAY HOURS OF OPERATION AND WASTE PICK-UP CHANGE

All Town of Newmarket buildings and facilities will be closed for Canada Day. Waste and recycling collection for Friday, July 1 will be moved to Saturday, July 2 due to the holiday. Please have all items to the curb for collection by 7 a.m.

SMOKE-FREE NEWMARKET

Smoking and vaping of cannabis, tobacco and other products is prohibited on all municipally-owned property including facilities, parks, open green spaces and trails. The by-law allows for Designated Smoking Areas at certain Town-owned facilities, where only smoking and vaping of tobacco will be permitted.

FIREWORKS RULES AND REMINDERS

- Fireworks are only allowed on June 30, July 1 and 2
- Setting off fireworks on Town parks and open spaces is not allowed.
- Only set off fireworks on your own property and only if the front of your property is a minimum of at least 18m (59ft.) wide.
- Only use fireworks between dusk (approx. 9:30 p.m.) and 11 p.m. Please be mindful of your neighbours and pets and do not set off fireworks after 11 p.m.
- Please do not litter. Clean up and dispose of the fireworks when finished.

TIPS TO REDUCE ENCOUNTERS WITH COYOTES

- Remove any food attractants.
- Do not feed coyotes or leave any type of food outdoors for any animal.
- Store all garbage in tightly sealed containers.
- Use motion sensitive lights in yards or gardens
- Ensure spaces around/ under decks or sheds are closed off
- Remember to never leave children unattended
- Never let your pet run at large, keep your pet on a leash at all times (except when in the Newmarket Dog Park)
