Remember to admire wildlife from afar. Don't feed bread to geese or ducks - doing so may have long term impact. Feeding bread to geese or ducks at the lake may sound harmless, but this may cause defects such as Angel Wing - a condition can leave geese unable to fly and migrate south for the winter.
